

Martin Luther King Youth Day of Service - January 15, 2018

Hosted by The Church of Saint Ann in partnership with the Center for FaithJustice

The day will begin with registration at 8:30am followed by a brief opening prayer service. Participants will then head out in small groups to a variety of pre-assigned service sites (driven and accompanied by an adult chaperone). They will return to the parish for lunch, small group reflections and a closing prayer service. The day will end around 2:30pm. We encourage families to sign up but a child can register **without** an adult family member registering.

The day is open to youth in grades 6-12 and their adult driver chaperones. This is a great opportunity for those preparing for Confirmation and/or in need of service hours for school or church!

Cost:

- For St. Ann participants: \$25 & a toiletry item for HomeFront
- Chaperones pay nothing
- Cost includes a pizza lunch, staffing and programming
